SETUP/SUPPLIES

- Rescues may sell goods (not including food/beverage concessions) or provide services and information. Rescues selling goods must be in good standing with the Town of Parker and are required to complete the sales tax form provided and submit the applicable sales taxes.
- Rescue spaces are approximately 20'x20' unless otherwise specified. Rescues must provide own supplies including tents/weights, tables, chairs, and food/drinks.
- ALL tents must be weighted/anchored adequately.
- You will need to bring supplies to care for your dogs including crates, ex pens, toys, and <u>water</u>.
- Water and electrical hookups are not available.
- There will be a food truck attending but we recommend bringing food just in case.
- This is an outdoor event on grass; please be prepared for the weather conditions of the day.
- Check-in begins at 7:00 AM. All rescues must set up by 9:30 AM and wait to begin break down until the end of the event at 2:00 PM.
- All attendees must sign safety waiver prior to event or at check-in and a complete list of dogs present must be provided.

AWARD

- 100% of the profits from the festival will be donated to rescues.
- The checks will be mailed out after the event once the final numbers are calculated.

SHIRTS:

- Event Shirts are available for pre-order **only** for \$25 each.
- Submit payment with application form.

COMMUNICATION:

- Communication is **vital** for an event of this nature.
- We need all rescues to respond to all correspondence in a timely manner.
- All correspondence will have a reasonable response deadline.
- Failure to reply before the deadline may result in exclusion from the festival.


ADDITIONAL DETAILS

DOGS

- Rescues may bring personal dogs but they cannot participate in the games without registering.
- We request that adoptable dogs wear bandanas or other identifying items to indicate that they are available.
- Adoptable dogs are encouraged to participate in the games to increase visibility.
- Adoptable dogs are not required to pay a registration fee.
- Dogs must be leashed or contained at all times. If using a playpen, it must be staked down securely and all dogs must be wearing leashes. No slip leads please.
- Dog to handler ratio must not exceed 2:1.

EVENT LOCATION:

- The Google Maps directions WILL NOT take you to the park.
- Drive to the intersection of N Motsenbocker Rd. and Triple Crown St. in Parker.
- It is located between Town of Parker Parks Division and American Design and Landscape.
- Once you arrive, you'll see signs pointing toward the event space.
